

## Small Group Discussion Guide January 15, 2017

## **Sermon Title:**

"Share Jesus . . . in Worship"

**Sermon Text:** Acts 16:22-34 **Scripture Reading**: Revelation 7:9-17

**Leader:** Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting, and then have someone

offer a brief prayer for God to meet with your group.

**Getting Started:** Share about a unique or especially moving worship experience you have experienced. What made it unique or so moving?

## **Discussion:**

- 1. Does not require a specific time (v 25). Why do we pay so much attention to time as it relates to worship (convenient time, starting time, ending time)? Do you have a regular practice of worship at a non-traditional time?
- 2. Does not require a specific method (v 25). Paul and Silas sang hymns and prayed, very simple. Are there elements that just "make" your worship? Are there elements that "interrupt" your worship? Is there really a right or wrong way? (see John 4:24)
- **3. Does not require a specific location** (vs 23-24). What is the intended function of dedicated worship spaces? Congregations invest a lot in facilities to house worship, but are they necessary? What makes worship experiences outside of church buildings unique and special?
- **4. Does not require a specific circumstance** (v 23). We often think of worship as a happy or joyful expression. Have you been driven to worship as a result of some negative circumstance? Why do we not instinctively worship when things go wrong? (see 1 Thessalonians 5:18)
- **5. Does require a connection with God** (v 25). There is but one focus for our worship. Are there ways the church, or we individually, confuse the purpose?
- **6. Does require a connection with others** (v 25). Not all worship is corporate. However, other people may be moved by our worship (see John 12:32). Are you aware, has your worship ever affected someone else? How can you intentionally share Jesus as an act of personal worship?
- **7. Does require God's movement** (v 26). God is the active agent that brings worship to its culmination. How do we try to "create" God movements? Are these helpful/harmful?
- **8. Does require integrity/authenticity** (vs 27-28). Read 1 Thessalonians 5:18 again. What defines authentic worship?

**Closing:** Close by praying for each other. Go and **SHARE JESUS!**
