

## Small Group Discussion Guide January 22, 2017

## **Sermon Title:**

"Share Jesus . . . in Relationship"

Sermon Text: Philippians 3:4b-14
Scripture Reading: Psalm 24:1-6

**Leader:** Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting, and then have someone offer a brief prayer for God to meet with your group.

**Getting Started:** Share about the first friendship you can recall making? What made it so special? Is that relationship still intact?

## **Discussion:**

- 1. At the heart of "Evangelical" Christianity is the belief that everyone must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Is this a phrase you understand? Can you remember when you first heard it? Who shared it with you?
- **2.** Do you think that phrase is generally understood by everyone, or does it need some level of explanation?
- **3.** Do you see a correlation between that phrase and our mission statement: "To Share Jesus-in Worship-*IN RELATIONSHIP* in Service"?
- **4.** As we think about becoming acquainted with someone, consider these steps we may follow in developing a relationship. We must earn our right to "share Jesus" with them.
  - 1) We know "of" them.
  - 2) We know "about" them.
  - 3) We know them as a friend.
  - 4) We know them intimately.
- **5.** When thinking of being in a relationship with Jesus, the same pattern holds true. Think about how you came to know Jesus through the same process:
  - 1) You know "of" Him. Who first told you? a parent, a pastor, S.S. teacher?
  - 2) You know "about" Him. Who has taught you the most about Jesus?
  - 3) You know Him as a Friend. Do you see Jesus as your friend? (Ref. John 15:15)
  - 4) You know Him intimately. Is
- **6.** Jesus tried to simplify what it means to be in relationship with Him. **(Ref. John 14:1)** What do you think He was trying to communicate?
- **7.** Paul's desire to know Jesus became all-consuming. How did he compare it? **(Vs. 8)** Can you say this describes your desire to know Jesus?
- 8. Consider these lyrics to our closing song: "In the Secret." Do they speak for you?
- Vs.1- In the secret, in the quiet place, in the stillness You are there.

  In the secret, in the quiet hour I wait only for You, 'cause I want to know You more.

Cho: I want to know You. I want to hear Your voice. I want to know You more. I want to touch You, I want to see Your face. I want to know You more.

**Closing:** Close by praying for each other. Go and **SHARE JESUS!**
