

## Small Group Discussion Guide May 21, 2017

## **Sermon Title:**

"When Friends Become Family"

Sermon Text: John 19:25-27
Scripture Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:1-10

**Leader:** Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting, and then have someone

offer a brief prayer for God to meet with your group.

**Getting Started:** If you had a family crisis going on, who would be the first person you called?

Are they family- or a friend?

## **Discussion:**

- 1. Jesus was dying. He was hanging on the cross with only hours to minutes to live. In that brief time, (when he uttered 7 sayings), he took the time to establish a caring relationship between his Mother, Mary, and his closest friend, the Apostle John. What does that say about Jesus' and John's relationship?
- **2.** Did Jesus have any other family he could have entrusted Mary to? (Reference: Matthew 13:55, 56) How many in total?
- **3.** Do you know what it's like to have siblings or other family NOT believe in you or support you and you life dreams and goals? (Reference: John 7:5) Jesus knows!
- **4.** The Pastor mentioned a few things that help us establish relationships with our closest friends that may become even closer than our "blood relatives." Here are a few:
  - \* Mutual love.
  - \*Faithfulness
  - \*Shared Values
  - \*Field-tested Endurance
- **5.** Can you think of examples where people have stepped up for you and filled in a gap your family may have created?
- **6.** To whom can you serve as a "surrogate" family? (There are many lonely people in the world today.
- 7. What opportunities will you take this week to show familial love? Are there those in church you would like to develop a closer relationship with? What is preventing you from doing that?
