

Small Group Discussion Guide June 11, 2017

Sermon Title:

"Family Matters: Getting Along with the In-Laws"

Sermon Text: 1 Samuel 18:20-30, 19:8-12 Scripture Reading: Ruth 1:1-18

Leader: Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting, and then have someone offer a brief prayer for God to meet with your group.

Getting Started: Are you a part of an "in-law" relationship? In what capacity? Perhaps as both Father/Mother AND Son/Daughter? Discuss. How long has that relationship been in place? What have you learned about your In-law during that time? Have you learned anything about yourself as an in-law?

Discussion:

- 1. The Bible is filled with "in-law" stories. During the service Sunday, there were two specific ones highlighted: 1) Naomi and Ruth, and 2) Saul and David. What do you know about either? What place did each occupy in the "in-law" relationship?
- 2. How were David and Saul first introduced? (Reference: 1 Samuel 16:14-23) What service did David perform for Saul?
- 3. How did David become Saul's son-in-law? (Reference: I Samuel 18:20-22, 27)
- 4. What was Saul's motive for wanting David to marry his daughter? (Reference: 18:21)
- **5.** The Pastor mentioned 4 guidelines for giving your "in-law" relationship the best possible chance for success. Consider these and discuss the results of failing to live by them.
 - * Show Unconditional Love. How can you best do this?
 - * Let Go of Your Child. As a parent, we are told our children are to leave us. (Reference: Genesis 2:24) What is our child then instructed to do?
 - * Allow the Relationship to Develop Naturally. Do not "force fit" an expected relationship. Give it time to form.
 - * Respect Boundaries. We all like to set limits. Do you respect those set by others?

Closing: Close by sharing pray requests. Praying for one other and each other's families. **Go Share Jesus in Service!**
