

Small Group Discussion Guide July 16, 2017

Sermon Title:

"The Question We All Must Ask"

Sermon Text: Matthew 20:29-34 Scripture Reading: Psalm 139

Leader:

Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting, and then have someone offer a brief prayer for God to meet with your group.

Getting Started: When you were a child, do you remember asking someone an embarrassing question for which a parent had to apologize? As a parent, did any of your children ever do this?

Discussion:

- 1. We are re-visiting the same scripture lesson this week that we had last week. What do you remember about the location of the event and the road Jesus and his disciples were traveling?
- 2. In what city did the event take place? What do you remember about the event? What was the outcome?
- **3.** Review the question that Jesus asked the blind men. **(Vs. 32)** We are going to reconsider it with a different twist.
- **4.** With grateful hearts for what God has done for us in Christ, let's consider asking the question to God: "What do you want me to do for You?" Have you ever personally asked God this question before?
- **5.** If you dare ask God this question, you must be ready to receive an answer! How might He choose to communicate to us?
 - *Commandments given in scripture
- *Circumstances arranged by God
- *Counsel from Godly people
- * The Confirmation of the Holy Spirit
- **6.** If you are interested in a place to serve, please talk to one of the Pastors. We have several spots for you to plug in!

Closing: Close by sharing pray requests. Also, everyone share the name of a friend. Pray for one other, your friends, and the requests that were shared.
