

Small Group Discussion Guide September 24, 2017

Sermon Title:

"Searching for God"

Sermon Text: Jeremiah 29:10-14 **Scripture Reading**: 1 Kings 19:9-12

Leader:

Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting, and then have someone offer a brief prayer for God to meet with your group.

Getting Started: What is your normal response when you misplace or lose something? Do you search for it until you find it or give up after a relatively short time? Do you ever go back to the same place and start your search all over again? That is insanity!

Discussion:

- 1. Saint Augustine is quoted to have said, "Thou hast made us for Thyself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it finds rest in Thee." How do you understand this quote. Does it find application in your life?
- 2. Jeremiah 29:11 is a familiar verse. (Read it.) Have you ever heard this verse used around the church? FYI- The gifts we give to our graduating seniors have this verse engraved on it.
- 3. Have you ever felt like you were searching for God, but couldn't find Him? (Reference verse 13) When does God say He will be found? Are you doing that?
- **4.** God wants to make His presence known to us. The issue is that sometimes God may choose to be a little more subtle that we desire. How might He make His presence known? Consider each of these events as a successful search for God:
 - *An obvious answer to prayer
 - *An unexpected evidence of God's grace and care
 - *Any unusual linkage or timing
 - *Any help to do God's work in the world
