

## Small Group Discussion Guide February 4, 2018

## **Sermon Title:**

"The Key to Success"

**Sermon Text:** 2 Chronicles 26:1-5 **Scripture Reading**: 1 Corinthians 11:23-29

**Leader:** Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting. Have someone offer a brief

prayer inviting God to speak and lead using the group's discussion.

**Getting Started:** If a teenager were to ask you, "In the areas in life where you have been the

most successful, what would be the key(s) to your success?", how would you

answer them?

## Discussion:

- 1. At what age would you say you made one of your most life-determining decisions? Do you see young people making those type of decisions at that age today? (King Tutankhamen ("King Tut") became Pharoah of Egypt at age 10!)
- 2. Uzziah became king of Judah (capital: Jerusalem) at what age? (Reference Vs.3) What sort of events were happening in your life at that age?
- 3. Verse 5 clearly spelled out the "KEY (singular) to SUCCESS" for him. What was it?
- 4. What were some of the accomplishments he went on to experience? (Reference: Vs. 6,7.......9,10........ Vs.11) Do we have any other experience with King Uzziah? (Reference: Isaiah 6)
- **5.** While seeking the Lord is the obvious key to success, the Pastor mentioned 6 areas that are common with highly successful people today. Consider these and how well you are doing with each of them. Successful people......
  - \*master their moods. (Reference: Proverbs 25:28)
  - \*watch their words. (Reference: Proverbs 13:3)
  - \*restrain their reactions. (Reference: Proverbs 19:11)
  - \*heed their health
  - \*manage their money. (Reference: Proverbs 21:20)
  - \*stick to their schedule (Reference: Ephesians 5:15)

**Closing:** Close by sharing prayer requests.

Pray for each another and for the needs that were shared.
