



## Small Group Discussion Guide

February 18, 2018

### Sermon Title:

"The Value of Clarity"

**Sermon Text:** Acts 8:26-40

**Scripture Reading:** 1 Corinthians 2:6-16

**Leader:** *Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting. Have someone offer a brief prayer inviting God to speak and lead using the group's discussion.*

**Getting Started:** When you were in school, what was your hardest subject? Who helped you understand it, and what method worked the best for you?

### Discussion:

1. How frequently do you think about the "mystery of the gospel"? When you consider it, this is truly an amazing story we have been entrusted to share. (Reference: Matthew 13:11)
2. If you were asked to share the gospel, how would you begin? At what place in the Bible might you begin to share the scriptures?
3. Who were the two main characters in the scriptural passage today? What do we know of them?
4. Who first told Philip to go on this particular road? (Reference: Vs.26) Later, Who then gave the specific instructions for him to go? (Reference: Vs. 29) Do you see any significance in the switch?
5. Consider these questions that come up in the dialogue between Philip and the eunuch:
  - \*Do you understand what you are reading? (Vs.30)
  - \*How can I unless someone explains it to me? (Vs.31)
  - \*Who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else? (Vs.34)
6. How important of a role does this scripture play in the conversion of the eunuch? Why do you think he may have had a personal interest in verse 33? (What is a eunuch?) (Reference Isaiah 53 and compare verses 32,33)
7. Could you have such a "conversion conversation" with a child/grandchild or friend?

**Closing:** *Close by sharing prayer requests.*

*Pray for each another and for the needs that were shared.*
