

Small Group Discussion Guide June 17, 2018

Sermon Title:

"What REAL Men Know"

Sermon Text: 2 Timothy 3:10-17 Scripture Reading: Psalm 142

Leader: Please allow a moment for introductions/visiting. Have someone offer a brief

prayer inviting God to speak and lead using the group's discussion.

Getting Started: Who are the top 5 men in your life who have influenced you and why?

How many of them are still living?

Discussion:

1. It was clear that the Apostle Paul loved Timothy. How did Paul refer to him in the scripture? (Reference" 1 Timothy 1:2) How do you think this relationship began?

- 2. We have reference to Timothy's Mother being a woman of faith as well as his Grandmother. (Reference: 2 Timothy 1:5) Do we know anything of his Father? (Reference: Acts 16:1) What nationality was he?
- 3. When we read of Timothy's upbringing, we see a definitive Christian training. (Reference: 2 Timothy 3:15) How early did Timothy's training begin? Have you taken the time to train your children in the Holy Scriptures? How about your grandchildren?
- **4.** Many men in today's culture take the position of leaving the "spiritual training" up to Mothers. In light of scripture, do you think this is correct? **(Reference: Ephesians 6:4)**
- **5.** Before a Father can adequately train his children, there are some things he has to have settled in his heart. The Pastor mentioned these, although this is not an exhaustive list: (PS.....Some of these may sound very similar to our "Graduate Sunday" sermon. That is because the points are applicable to any age!)

The world is confused about what a "real man" is. Let's SHOW them!

- *Know who you are.
- *Know WHOSE you are.
- *Know what you are here for.
- *Know where you are going.
- *Know how to take others with you.

Closing: Close by sharing prayer requests. Pray for each another and for the needs that were shared. **Have a blessed week. GO SHARE JESUS!**
